SUPPLEMENTRAY REGULATIONS

ANNOUNCEMENT

Held under the ACU National Sporting Code and standing Enduro regulations, 2018 ACU British Time Card Enduro championship regulations, these Supplementary regulations and any final instructions issued.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to ACU and SACU License holders, one-event licenses will be available if a rider does not hold a valid competition license. Start permission will be required for riders from other governing bodies.

The Enduro includes the use of public highways and it is the sole responsibility of the rider to ensure that their machine is roadworthy and that the rider and the machine comply with all legal requirements.

Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a license issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident Insurance.

INSURANCE note:- this is an ACU Premier Insurance Event

Each rider will be required to declare that there will be insurance in force in relation to the use of the machine which they intend to ride during the event, such a policy of insurance or such a security in respect of Third Party risks, as complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Acts, and which is operative whilst taking part in the event. Road Traffic Insurance Cover is available at Signing On through the ACU.

CLASSES

As per 2018 ACU British Time Card Enduro championship regulations A Sportsman class will be available for entry

EVENT DETAILS

This Time Card Enduro, starts from the Start compound 9am on both days.

Day 1 and 2 – The course will use track and plantations across the Isle of Man taking in cross country and plantation special tests. Full details will be provided in final instructions and at the start area.

There are no closed roads in this event, please be alert for walkers, horses, cyclists and other road users. Please **CLOSE GATES** afterwards. The route will be marked on the day of the event. **ALL RIDERS ARE REMINDED NOT TO RACE ON THE ROADS.**

START COMPOUND

Parc Ferme will NOT be in place at this event

Competitors are required to place their machines in a start compound 15 minutes prior to their start time each day.

MACHINE SECURITY

The organisers will take no responsibility for the security of machines and possessions whilst attending this event. It is the sole responsibility of the individual to protect possessions from loss. There will be no secure storage for machines or equipment provided at this event.

<u>Transponders</u> will be used to time special tests. Transponders are the sole responsibility of the rider once issued at signing on. If the transponder is not returned at the end of the event, riders have 7 days to return it to T Timing Ltd (address available from manxduro@southernmcc.com), after 7 days the rider will be billed for the cost of the transponder in full – no exceptions to this. The fee is £263.00. This also applies to any rider that loses a transponder.

Every rider will be required to leave a bond for their transponder, for example a full ACU licence. If you don't have a licence available a credit or debit card or £20.00 in cash will be accepted. The time keepers take this bond to ensure the return of the transponder.

RE-FUELLING

Designated re-fuelling areas will be provided around the course. Competitors must conform to the ACU environmental code including use of a environmental mat.

NOISE TESTING

Machines will be tested at machine examination and may be randomly tested as per ACU Control of Exhaust Noise Regulations

REGISTRATION AND MACHINE EXAMINATION

Riders are required to sign on presenting a valid ACU completion licence and submit machines for examination on Friday 6th July at the start area, 4.00pm until 9.30pm. Only machines that have passed examination will be permitted into the start compound on the day of the event.

ROUTE MARKERS

Day 1 Course will be marked in ORANGE day-glo arrows.

Day 2 will be marked in GREEN day-glo arrows.

RIDER NUMBERS

Pre-printed adhesive numbers will be provided to all riders at signing on. These numbers should be used for the duration of the event. Numbers will be allocated in accordance with ACU rules.

IMPORTANT: the landowners will be in attendance at the meeting, so it is imperative that all riders and attendants follow the ACU code of conduct. Naturally course cutting, abuse of officials and foul language will result in disciplinary action
