SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

For an Enduro Event held under the National Sporting Code and the Standing Regulations of the ACU, these Supplementary Regulations, together with any Final Instructions issued or Official Announcements made.

ELIGIBILITY

- Adult solo competitors 16 years old and over
youth rider may enter adult sessions subject to:
 - 14 years of age – restricted to a maximum machine capacity of 125cc
 - 15 years of age - restricted to a maximum machine capacity of 250cc.
- Sessions will be scheduled for youth only, ACU standing regulation Group 3 Youth Enduro Riders
 - Ages 10-16 years
 - 85cc Small Wheel, 85cc Big Wheel, 125cc/150cc Beginner 125cc /150cc & Fun Bike.

All attendees must hold an ACU competition or practice licence. Competition licence must be presented when signing on.

EVENT DETAILS

Enduro practice, untimed and without results. Motocross bikes may be used. There are no public roads used during the event.

TYRES There are no restrictions on tyres MX tyres may be used.

ENTRIES

- Enter on the day
- Entry fee **£35 solo competitor**
- Club Membership (if required) **£5** one event or **£20** annual
- 1 day practice / ACU Enduro licence (if required) **£5**
- QR code must be shown at sign on

EVENT DETAILS

20 min sessions on a marked Enduro Practice track at Carnagrie, St Johns. Course is not graded and features some obstacles and hazards as it is run on a mixture of natural countryside and

existing track.

- Expert and Clubman class enduro competitors
- A Group MX competitors

B Group

- Novice and Sportsman & Veteran enduro competitors
- B & C Group MX competitors
- Youth 14 years of age max 125cc, 15 years of age max 250cc

Youth

- Ages 10-16 years, 85cc Small Wheel, 85cc Big Wheel, 125cc/150cc Beginner 125cc /150cc & Fun Bike

RESTRICTIONS

- No riding permitted outside the marked track
- Machines to be ridden at walking pace in blue tape areas
- No riding permitted in the paddock, bikes to be pushed to and from the start area
- Machines, fuel, tools to be kept in the start area between sessions
- No riding without a helmet
- No dangerous riding
- No course cutting

RE-FUELLING

Refuelling is permitted within the start area.


All riders MUST have a 2kg Dry Powder fire extinguisher, No smoking in the start area. Every rider is required to use an environmental mat (carpet offcut is acceptable)

If you do not hold a 2025 ACU Licence for Enduro or have not ridden an ACU event before follow these steps:



1. From your **Profile**, find this screen:




2. Choose **No Annual Payment**

When done you should have this:


